From New Britain (Hospital of Central Connecticut):

Take Grand Street (toward Walnut Hill Park). Grand Street becomes Hart Street. Turn right onto Hart Street, go 0.4 miles and turn right onto Corbin Avenue. Turn left onto West Main Street (CT-372). Continue to follow CT-372 for 1.3 miles. Turn left into 440 New Britain Avenue. (If you pass Kohl's/Lowes shopping center, you've gone too far).

From Hartford:

I-84 West toward Waterbury. Take exit 33 onto CT-72 West toward Plainville/Bristol. Take exit 2 onto CT-372 toward New Britain Avenue Plainville. Turn right onto New Britain Avenue. End at 440 New Britain Avenue.

From Southington:

I-84 East toward Hartford. Take exit 34 (Crooked Street) toward CT-372/Plainville. Turn left onto Crooked Street. At the lights, take right onto New Britain Avenue (CT-372). End at 440 New Britain Avenue.

From Bristol:

Take CT-72 East. Use the right lane to take exit 3-4, 84 West/ Woodford Avenue. Keep right to take exit 3, follow signs for Woodford Avenue. Turn left onto Woodford Avenue. (Woodford becomes White Oak Avenue). Turn left onto Crooked Street. Turn right onto New Britain Avenue (CT-372). End at 440 New Britain Avenue.

From New Haven:

I-91 North toward Hartford. Take exit 22 North onto CT-9 toward New Britain. Take exit 28 (left exit) onto CT-72 toward Bristol. Take exit 7 onto Corbin Avenue. Turn right onto Corbin Avenue. Turn left onto West Main Street (CT-372). Continue to follow CT-372 for 1.3 miles. Turn left into 440 New Britain Avenue. (If you pass Kohl's/Lowes shopping center, you've gone too far).

From Mystic:

I-95 South toward New London/ New Haven. Take exit 69 onto CT-9 toward Essex/Hartford. Take exit 28 onto CT-72 West toward Bristol. Take exit 7 onto Corbin Avenue. Turn right onto Corbin Avenue Turn left onto West Main Street (CT-372). Continue to follow CT-372 for 1.3 miles. Turn left into 440 New Britain Avenue. (If you pass Kohl's/Lowes Shopping center, you've gone too far).
